After School Childcare - from April 18th 2017

Opening Time

3-5pm daily, however, you may choose to book your child from 3 to 4.30pm or 3-5pm

How much will it cost for my child?

£3 per child, per hour. This will include an after school snack.

Second and further siblings will cost £2 per hour each.

Regular After School Clubs

For example, if your child attends modelling club on a Thursday, you will be charged from 3.45 to 4.30 or 5pm (as specified in your booking). However, in the unlikely event if modelling club is cancelled (before the end of the previous school day) you will be charged from 3-5pm.

Where will after school club be held?

After school club will take place in the kitchen and meeting room. Children will make their way to the kitchen at 3pm, or at end of the school club they attend (if appropriate). The leader will sign them in to a register. ALL bags and belongings should be taken to the kitchen. Children will not be allowed near the classroom areas. There is a toilet available next to the kitchen.

What will be on offer for my child eat?

A piece of fruit, biscuit or savoury snack will be available along with a drink for pupils. They may like to bring their own for after school club.

Medical dietary requirements need to be brought to the school's attention.

How do I book a place?

You can either book a place a week or term in advance. Or, book a place for your child by the end of the previous day for the next day. The system will run on a 'first come, first served' basis.

Please note: last minute bookings may not be accepted on the day if numbers are high as supervision ratios may be affected.

What will my child do?

There will be a variety of activities available to children each day. Special activities may be planned on occasion.

Each day children will:

- Have access to a quiet, cosy place to read, play a board game (example chess) or on occasion watch a film.
- Have access to a craft/art activity.
- Be encouraged to eat a snack and have a drink.
- Be able to complete homework

Special events will be planned, for example:

- Cooking
- Swimming (summer term only - when adequate adult supervision and carer consent)
- Sports— example a game of rounders
- Lego building
- Using the school grounds (wildlife area, field etc)

For further information, to book a place for your child, please contact the school.

There will be a fee for missed sessions if pre-booked places aren't cancelled by the end of the previous school day. If your child is absent from school, it will be assumed the childcare place after school is not needed therefore may be given to another child.
